**ENFORCEMENT OF LOCKDOWN REGULATIONS ISSUED IN TERMS OF THE  
DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002: MOVEMENT OF LIQUOR: ENGAGEMENT  
BETWEEN THE SOUTH AFRICAN BREWERIES AND SAPS**

1. An out of court settlement was reached between South African Breweries ("SAB") and Government regarding the transport of SAB products as part of a critical maintenance process at SAB.
2. This effectively means that, for a limited time period, SAB is permitted to transport its products, despite the prohibition on the transport of liquor in terms of regulation 26(2) of the Disaster Management Regulations, 2020.
3. The agreement revolves around the transport of SAB inventory from the seven SAB breweries to SAB secure depots during the Alert Level 4 restriction period (See attached list of breweries and depots).
4. For purposes of this instruction, "inventory" includes all SAB liquor products as well as empty bottles.
5. In terms of the agreement, SAB submitted a draft logistical plan to government for the orderly and safe transport of SAB inventory, setting out the particulars of movement of inventory. The draft logistical plan is subject to changes that may be required by the circumstances.
6. The transport of all SAB inventory is permitted for a period of 21 days as from 14 May 2020 and during this period, enforcement officers should allow the movement and transportation of the SAB inventory in order to give effect to the settlement agreement.
7. All PROVJOINTS to ensure that this is communicated to the relevant departments / members to ensure compliance.

### **Submission of SAB's draft logistical plan for the movement of Inventory**

We refer to the recently signed Settlement Agreement, and as required, we now attach in an Excel spreadsheet our draft of the logistical plan for the movement of the SAB inventory.

Set out below are what we regard as the most important points for your team to consider within each of the tabs of the attached Excel Spreadsheet.

#### **Tab 1 – Loads Summary**

This sets out the overview of the operations.

Please note we have planned to operate our Logistics staff at 60% capacity with no more than 2500 of our employees to manage 1343 loads to deliver a volume of 26m litres of inventory to our depots in the first 7 days starting tomorrow 13 May 2020 at 06h00. (We advise that there are no loads planned for the first Sunday.) If the number of employees is likely to exceed 2500 we will inform the Joint Operations Centre (JOC) accordingly.

The plan then sets out estimates for weeks 2 and 3, however, we will submit the daily actual plans to the JOC, and then we will consolidate all actual deliveries once a week.

To enable SAB to complete the Plan as envisaged, SAB needs to collect and transport empty returnable glass bottles from various sites, including its own Depots, back to the relevant SAB breweries where the bottles are required for packaging. This is not the movement of liquor but the issue has been raised for your attention to ensure there are no impediments to the completion of the Plan.

#### **Tab – 2 – Load details**

You will note this section details the source of the load, and its proposed destination. This is done by Brewery, and the important point to note is the SAB SAP Load Number. This number will flow throughout the process, and should be on all documents and on our internal system for tracking purposes.

Please note that these are estimated loads which are subject to change due to operational issues (such as availability of vehicles, re-planning, and breakdowns) and once again, the consolidation at the end of the first 7 days will clearly indicate the status of each load. For instance, was it delivered, was it cancelled or re-planned.
